- Site:** Completely recreated for its 2005 opening, the property is envisioned as a metropolitan boutique hotel with the comfort and ambience of a residential *pied-à-terre*. Originally built as an apartment complex, the four-story property underwent a complete renovation and interior re-design in 2004 and 2005 that retains the original floor plan. In May 2005 it debuted as Chamberlain. In 2006 it was included on *Condé Nast Traveler's "Hot List"* as one of the world's top new hotels.

Design:

Interior designer Leslie Barrett is overseeing the hotel's Spring 2010 renovation, its first since its opening in 2005, features an extensive remodel of all guestrooms, suites, bathrooms, and the roof-top outdoor pool deck, which offers stunning panoramic views of the Hollywood Hills, city skyline, and Pacific Ocean.

The new aesthetic is a modern-day interpretation of 1970s and 1980s-era contemporary glamour, inspired by urban capitals like Milan and New York – unique and eclectic, yet comfortable and soothing. The decor incorporates a palette of cool hues including periwinkle and cream, with rich accents of gold, dark chocolate and bronze. Cream and espresso gridlined carpeting anchors rich stone veneer, brassy metal and chrome detailing, and layers of graphic patterns inspired by the pivotal decades, such as grids, checkerboards and chevrons.

Guest Suites:

Chamberlain's 114 sizeable guest suites feature a stylish mix of classic furnishings, contemporary amenities and a cool, clean palette inventively styled to evoke the feel and spirit of a private home.

Guest rooms feature a loft-like, open-concept layout, some with vaulted ceilings, and use an Asian-inspired screen to separate the living quarters from the bedrooms. All-new bathrooms boast a blend of Negro Marquina, St. Laurent and Carrera marble throughout, as well as curbless showers, frameless glass shower doors, and custom-designed chrome frame vanities with marble tops. Other amenities include Sferra bed linens, LG 42" LCD televisions, Neil George Salon beauty products, high-speed Internet service, and more.

Intimate residential touches abound imbue each room with a home-away-from-home atmosphere. Each room is appointed with a gas-log fireplace, private balcony. A user-friendly entertainment center features LG 42" LCD televisions, CD-DVD players and media hubs with an on-command movie system.

For those traveling on business, suites are equipped with a spacious work station featuring high-speed Internet access, an over-sized desk, a two-line speaker phone with private voicemail and a laptop-

accommodating in-room safe.

Deluxe and Executive Suites range from 350 to 550 square feet and are designed in a unique, suite-like open floor plan divided by a separate, step-up sleeping area. Premier One-Bedroom Suites are 650 square feet, replete with separate bedroom and an expansive living area with queen-size convertible sofa bed. Select One-Bedroom Suites additionally feature a dining nook and kitchenette equipped with a microwave oven, wet-bar area, dishware, glassware, cookware, coffee maker and flatware. Chamberlain Two-Bedroom Suites offer up to 1,200 square feet of exclusive residential living.

Restaurant and Lounge: Tucked off the lobby, Chamberlain's in-house, modern Bistro and lounge conjure the ambience of a favorite neighborhood rendezvous, courtesy of Chef Jonathan Peters (Anisette, Church & State). Chef Peters has reinvigorated Bistro's California menu with a decidedly European-flavored infusion. The ingredient-driven menu combines the best of European and California cuisines to deliver fresh seasonal twists on traditional bistro fare with hearty meals and inventive cocktails. A companion bar menu of smaller plates and canapés presents an ideal, lighter-fare alternative that partners well with the clever cocktail selection and extensive list of wines and international beer.

The distinctive dining room is bathed in watery blues and teals and looks out through a 20-foot wall of floor-to-ceiling windows onto a lush garden patio of tropical palms and native foliage. An exotic lattice-pattern of turquoise and green tile lines the floor, highlighting the turquoise strié wallpaper, while dramatic lantern-shaped pendant lights in white gold illumine above.

This intimate restaurant seats 30, at both free-standing tables and banquets; the garden patio seats an additional 24.

Recreation:

A rooftop deck, with stunning 360-degree views of L.A.'s twinkling cityscape, entices guests to recline by the heated swimming pool or in a private cabana, where intimate receptions can also be hosted. Sleek lounging beds and chaises are upholstered in a sultry coal fabric and feature cumaru wood bases. The deck houses three semi-private, 8' x 4' demi-cabanas in natural white canvas trimmed with striking black contrasts. One fully-private 12' x 12' cabana can house six to eight people and offers a full banquette, with cushions, accent pillows and glass coffee table.

A 500-square-foot fitness facility with top-of-the-line cardiovascular equipment and free weights is located on the lobby floor of the hotel. Open 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Meetings and Private Events:

With a seating capacity for up to 25 participants (504 square feet), Chamberlain's state-of-the-art meeting room is ideal for small gatherings, intimate business meetings, sales presentations or unique events. On the rooftop pool patio, the spectacular views of Los Angeles and Hollywood provide an ideal setting for intimate receptions and celebrations.

Wireless Internet access is readily available in meeting and public areas, and the hotel's Business Center offers a complete range of services. Chamberlain's convenient location near Hollywood's entertainment industry, business centers and attractions, as well as LAX and Burbank Airports, provide extra incentive.
